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FOREWORD



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PREFACE

Department of Agriculture, Cooperation and Farmers Welfare, Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare conducts quinquennial Agriculture Census in the country to collect key information about the structure of agriculture holdings in the country and monitor changes that take place over time. The entire Agriculture Census operation is carried out in three Phases (Phase-I, Phase-II & Phase- III) which are statistically linked. So far, nine Agriculture Censuses have been conducted in the country and the present Census is the tenth in the series which has reference year as 2015-16 (July-June).

Beginning with 1970-71, the Department of Agriculture, Cooperation and Farmers Welfare has organized and conducted Agriculture Census activities with the active cooperation and support of State/UT Governments. In the Agriculture Census, the unit of enumeration is defined by the term 'Operational Holding' and it corresponds to the person who actually cultivates the land rather than its ownership. The concepts followed are broadly in conformity with the World Census of Agriculture, FAO of the United Nations.

The present report has been prepared based on the data collected through Phase-I of Agriculture Census 2015-16. It provides key results (provisional) on distribution of operational holdings at National level and for various States and UTs. The summary results on number and area of operational holdings are further classified by various size classes of holdings, social groups, types of holdings and gender.

I wish to appreciate the efforts made by officials and also by associated agencies who contributed towards the collection, compilation and processing of data for preparing this Report. In particular, I acknowledge the dedicated effort of the entire team of Agriculture Census Division of the Department of Agriculture, Cooperation and Farmers Welfare, Government of India and the commendable work of the officers of all the States/UTs' Agriculture Census Units.

Policy formulation is becoming increasingly dependent on data to enable sound decision making. Data related to agriculture holdings and their characteristics are essential for providing baseline data, understanding changes taking place, identifying issues in the sector and for effective monitoring and evaluation of development plans and programmes. I believe this Report will serve as a reference for policy decisions and will also support research studies in the agriculture and allied sectors for development and farmers welfare.

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INTRODUCTION

The Agriculture Censuses in India are being conducted quinquennially since 1970-71 as part of the World Census of Agriculture (WCA) of the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) of the U.N. The present Agriculture Census 2015-16 is the tenth in the series. The time series data generated through Agriculture Census provides valuable inputs for policy making and tracks changes in the agriculture sector over the years. The basic statistical unit for data collection in Agriculture Census is 'Operational Holding' rather than 'Ownership Holding' as the farm level decisions are taken by persons who operate the land and not by those who own it.

2. The Agriculture Census is conducted in three phases. In Phase-I, data are predominantly re-tabulated from the village land records. However, in States, where comprehensive land records are not maintained, data are collected through sample surveys and the results giving number and area of operational holdings at various administrative levels like Block/Tehsil, District and State are generated according to size classes, social groups, types of holdings and gender etc.

3. In the present report, in addition to the highlights of results (provisional) of Phase-I of Agriculture Census 2015-16, detailed tables relating to size categories of operational holdings, their distribution in various States/UTs by social groups (SC & ST) and gender (Male & Female) have been included. After detailed scrutiny of the data, results at lower administrative levels (Tehsil/District) for various States / UTs would also be prepared and released.

4. I avail this opportunity to place on record my sincere thanks and appreciation to the field and supervisory staff of State/UT Governments for their effort and cooperation in completing the work of Agriculture Census. I would also wish to commend the excellent efforts of the officers and staff of the Agriculture Census Division of this Department for continuously monitoring the census operations and providing technical and administrative support to the States/ UTs.

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Technical Notes

1. Definitions

Operational Holding:

All land which is used wholly or partly for agricultural production and is operated as one technical unit by one person alone or with others without regard to the title, legal form, size or location.

Technical Unit:

An unit of land which is under the same management and has the same means of production such as labour force, machinery and animals.

Operated area:

Operated area includes both cultivated and uncultivated area, provided part of it is put to agricultural production during the reference period. If, for instance, an operational holding consists of four survey numbers out of which one survey number is put to non-agricultural uses, the total area of the operational holding will be equal to the total geographical area of all the four survey numbers.

Operational holder:

A person who has the responsibility for the operation of the agricultural holding and who exercises the technical initiative and is responsible for its operation. He may have full economic responsibility or may share it with others. The operational holder may be Individual/Joint/Institutional.

- i) *Individual:* If the holding is being operated either by one person or by a group of persons who are the members of the

same household, such holding will be considered as an individual holding.

- ii) *Joint*: If two or more persons belonging to different households, share jointly as partners in the economic and technical responsibility for the operation of an agricultural holding, such holding will be considered as joint holding.
- iii) *Institutional*: Holdings such as government farms, farms of sugarcane factories, cooperative farms, lands managed by trusts would be treated as institutional holdings.

All India Report on Number and Area of operational holdings – 2015-16

Introduction

The Agriculture Census in India is conducted at five yearly intervals to collect data on structural aspects of operational holdings in the country. The Agriculture Census programme is carried out in three phases at five yearly intervals with cooperation of States/UTs. The Government of India provides a financial and administrative support as well as all technical guidance to States/UTs required for Census operations. In each State/UT a nucleus staff of the State Government, designated as State Agriculture Census Unit is responsible for coordinating the activities of Agriculture Census Programme at the State/UT level.

The reference period for Agriculture Census is the Agricultural year (July-June). The first comprehensive Agriculture Census in the country was conducted with reference year 1970-71. So far, nine Agriculture Censuses have been conducted in the country. The current Agriculture Census with reference year 2015-16 is tenth in the series. Being the ultimate unit for taking agriculture-related decisions, operational holding has been taken as statistical unit at micro-level for data collection.

During Phase-I of the Agriculture Census, data on primary characteristics like number of operational holdings and area operated by different size classes (marginal, small, semi-medium, medium and large), social groups (SC, ST, Others), gender (male/female), types of holding (individual, joint and institutional), is collected. This operation covers all villages in land record States and 20 per cent of the villages in non-land record States.

During Phase-II of the Census, holding schedule is canvassed in selected 20 percent villages in each tehsil for collecting detailed data on characteristics of operational holdings such as land use, irrigation status, tenancy particulars, cropping pattern, etc. Phase – III of the Census, popularly known as Input Survey, relates to collection of data on the pattern of input use by operational holdings. This survey is conducted in 7 percent of villages selected in each tehsil of the State/UTs.

This report on number and area of operational holdings in India is based on the provisional results of first Phase of the current Agriculture

Census 2015-16. The detailed data at lower administrative levels (district/tehsil etc.) for States and UTs are also being verified by the concerned States and UTs. After, completion of the data verification, the final results would be released within the shortest possible time.

2. Methodology and Sampling design

The Agriculture Census data is collected following two broad approaches; in States where comprehensive land records exist (Land Record States), for Phase-I of the Census, the data on primary characteristics of operational holdings are collected and compiled on complete enumeration basis through re-tabulation of information available in the Village Land Records.

For other States (Non-Land record States), this data is collected through sample survey in 20 per cent of villages in each block. These villages are selected through simple random sampling method and all the operational holdings in the selected villages are enumerated following household enquiry approach. The sample villages are same as those selected for the scheme Establishment of an Agency for Reporting of Agricultural Statistics (EARAS) for the reference year of the Census.

The States where data collected through household enquiry approach include, viz. Kerala, Meghalaya, Manipur, Nagaland, Odisha, Tripura, Sikkim, West Bengal, Arunachal Pradesh, Goa, Mizoram, Punjab and a few Districts of the State of Assam. In smaller UTs, like Lakshadweep, Daman & Diu etc., no sampling is done. i.e. all holdings in all the villages are surveyed for collection of data.

During Phase-I Agriculture Census 2015-16, the computerized data of ownership holdings were also utilized for data collection in a few States. In such States, the ownership data was retrieved from the computerized land records and latter converted to operational holdings after verification by the field functionaries.

3. Highlights of the Report on Number and Area of Operational Holdings, 2015-16:

3.1 The total number of operational holdings in the country has increased from 138 million in 2010-11 to 146 million 2015-16 i.e. an increase of 5.33%.

3.2 The data for 2015-16 Agriculture Census reveals that in a total of 146 million operational holdings in the country, the highest number of operational holders belonged to Uttar Pradesh (23.82 million) followed by Bihar (16.41 million), Maharashtra (14.71 million), Madhya Pradesh (10.00 million), Karnataka (8.68 million), Andhra Pradesh (8.52 million), Tamil Nadu (7.94 million), Rajasthan (7.65 million), West Bengal (7.24 million). As regards operated area, out of a total of 157.14 million ha, the highest operated area was contributed by Rajasthan (20.87 million ha), followed by Maharashtra (19.88 million ha), Uttar Pradesh (17.45 million ha), Madhya Pradesh (15.67 million ha), Karnataka (11.72 million ha) etc.

3.3 At all India level, percentage increase in number of operational holdings in 2015-16 as compared to Agriculture Census 2010-11 worked out to 5.33% among states, the highest variation was found in the case of Madhya Pradesh (12.74%) followed by Andhra Pradesh (11.85%), Rajasthan (11.12%), Kerala (11.02%), Meghalaya (10.90%), Karnataka (10.78%) and Nagaland (10.50%) etc.

3.4 There is a decrease in the operated area from 159.59 million ha. in 2010-11 to 157.14 million ha. in 2015-16 showing an decrease of 1.53%.

3.5 Some states also showed decline in number of operational holdings. The sharpest fall has been in Goa (28.17%) and lowest in Manipur (0.09%). However, operated area has shown declining trends in most of the states.

3.6 As per Agriculture Census 2015-16, out of 36 States/UTs in the country, it was found that 14 States viz. Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Odisha, Rajasthan, Tamilnadu, Telangana, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal account for about 91.03% in terms of number of operational holdings and about 88.08% in terms of area operated in the country.

3.7 The average size of operational holding has declined to 1.08 ha. in 2015-16 as compared to 1.15 in 2010-11.

3.8 The individual, joint and institutional holdings have shown a growth of 5.04%, 7.07% and 10.88% respectively over previous Agriculture Census.

3.9 The percentage share of female operational holders has increased from 12.79% in 2010-11 to 13.87% in 2015-16 with the corresponding figures of 10.36% and 11.57% in the operated area. This shows that more and more females are participating in the management and operation of agricultural lands.

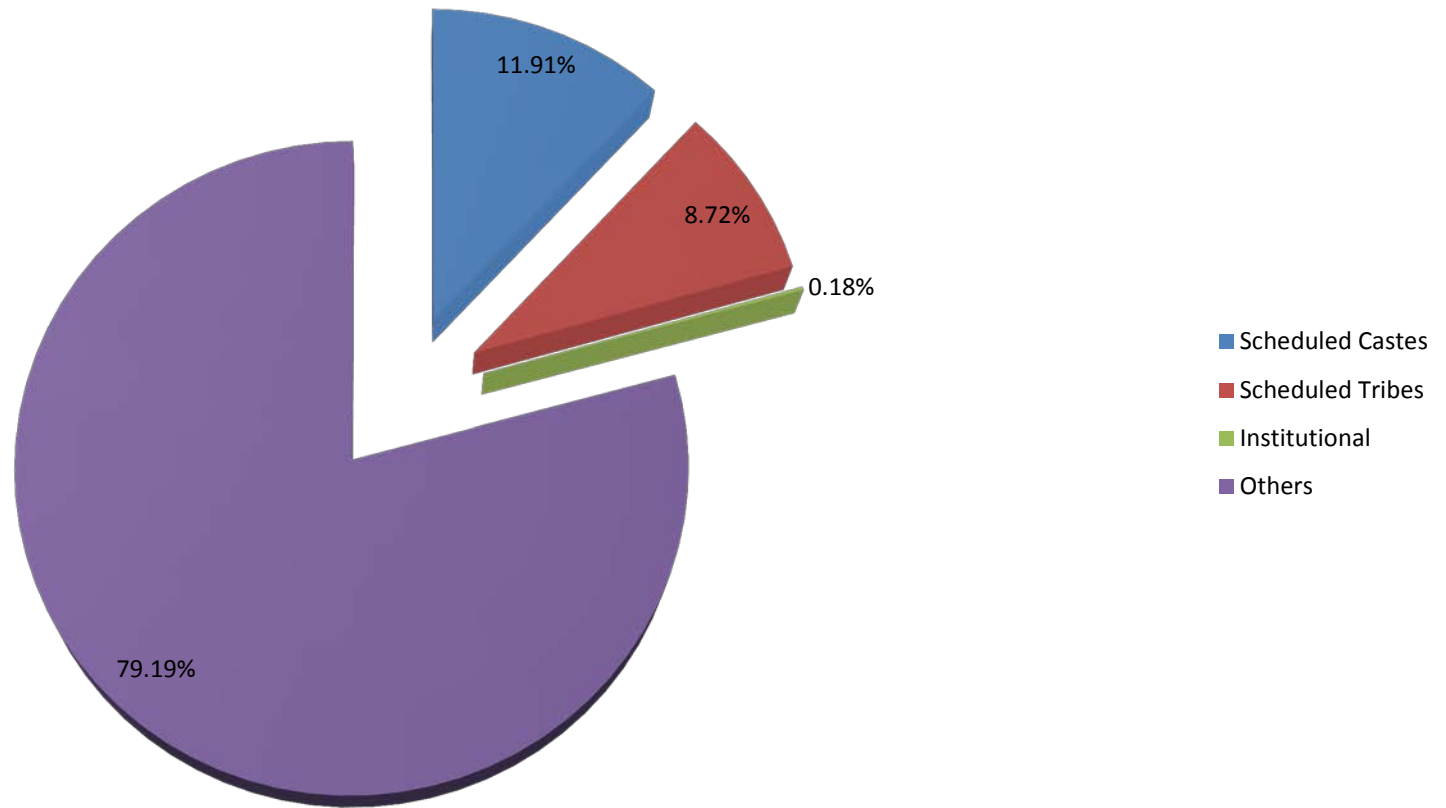
3.10 The small and marginal holdings taken together (0.00-2.00 ha) constituted 86.21% in 2015-16 against 84.97% in 2010-11 while their share in the operated area stood 47.34% in the current census as against 44.31% in 2010-11.

3.11 Semi-medium and Medium operational holdings (2.00-10.00 ha) in 2015-16 were only 13.22% with 43.61% operated area. The corresponding figures for 2010-11 census was 14.29% and 44.82%.

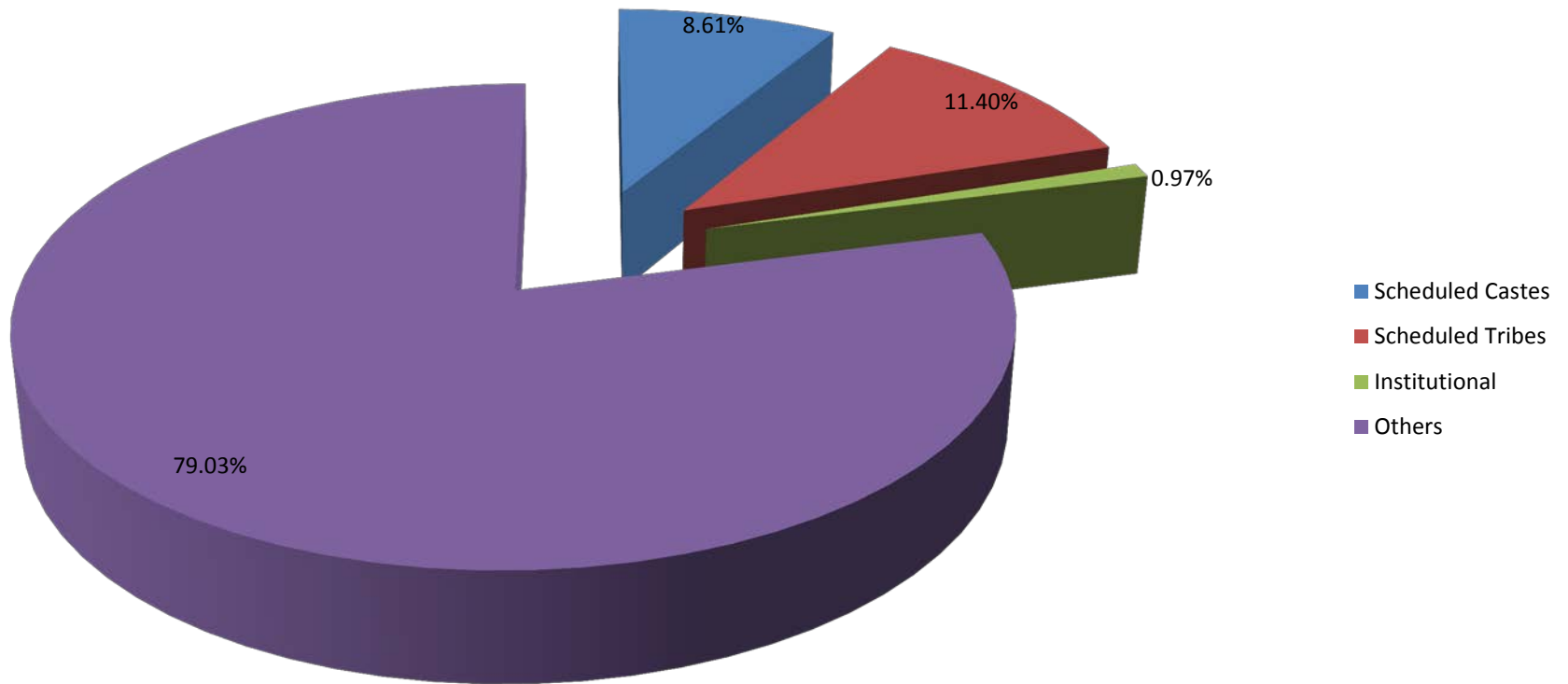
3.12 The large holdings (10.00 ha & above) were merely 0.57% of total number of holdings in 2015-16 and had a share of 9.04% in the operated area as against 0.71% and 10.59% respectively for 2010-11 census.

3.13 A set of tables giving all India distribution of number of operational holdings and area operated and the state-wise breakup of distribution of the number of operational holdings and area operated by major size groups is presented in the tables that follow.

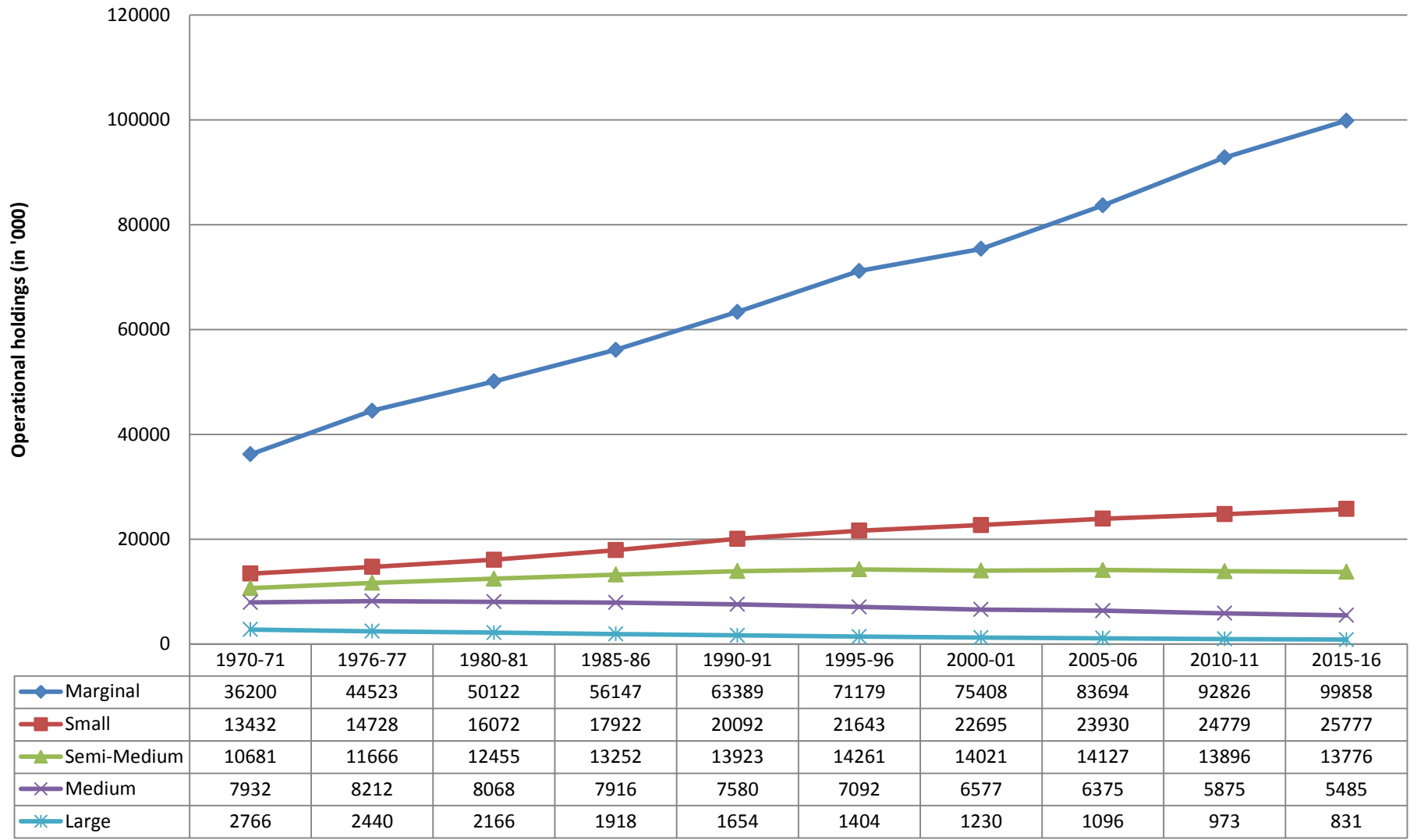
Percentage share of different social groups in number of operational holdings as per Agriculture Census 2015-16



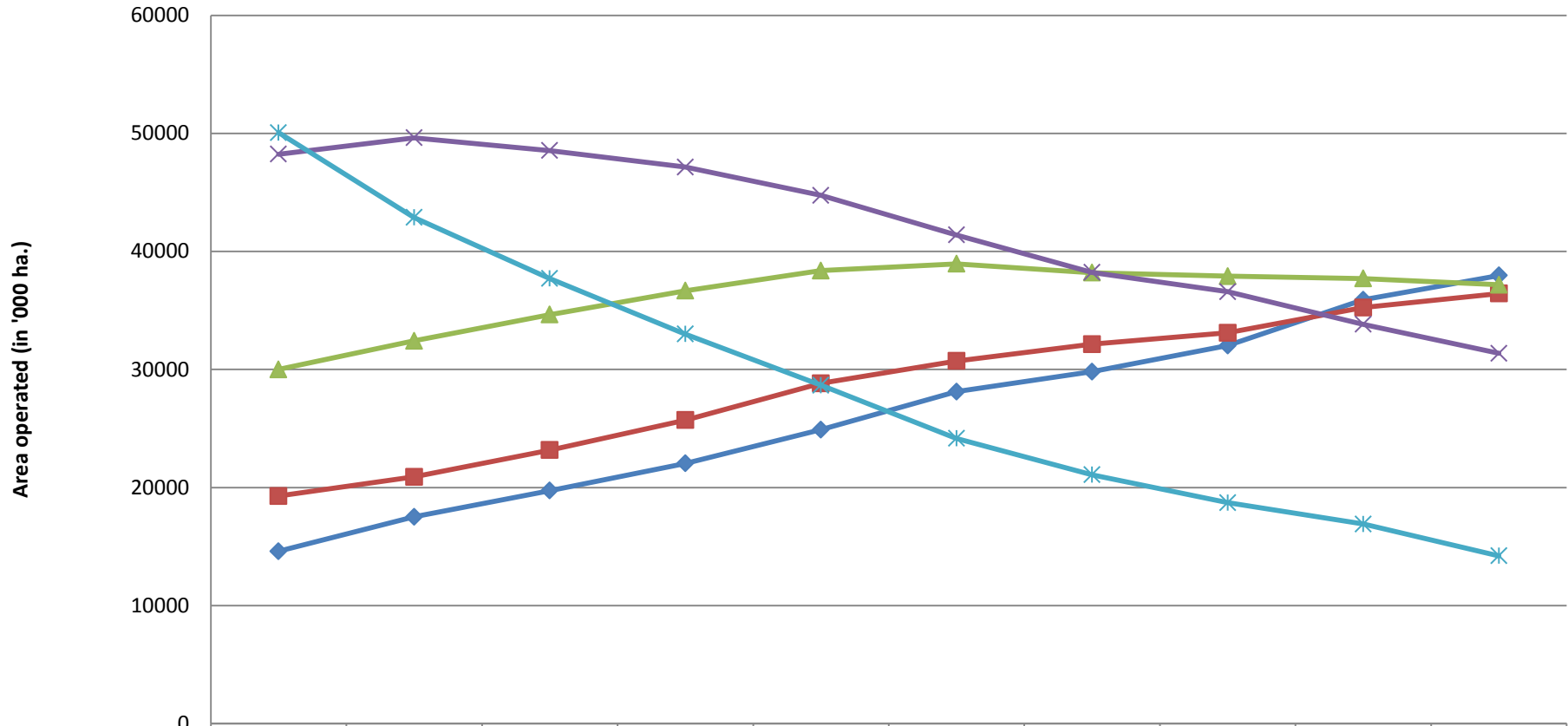
Percentage share of different social groups in area operated by holdings as per Agriculture Census 2015-16

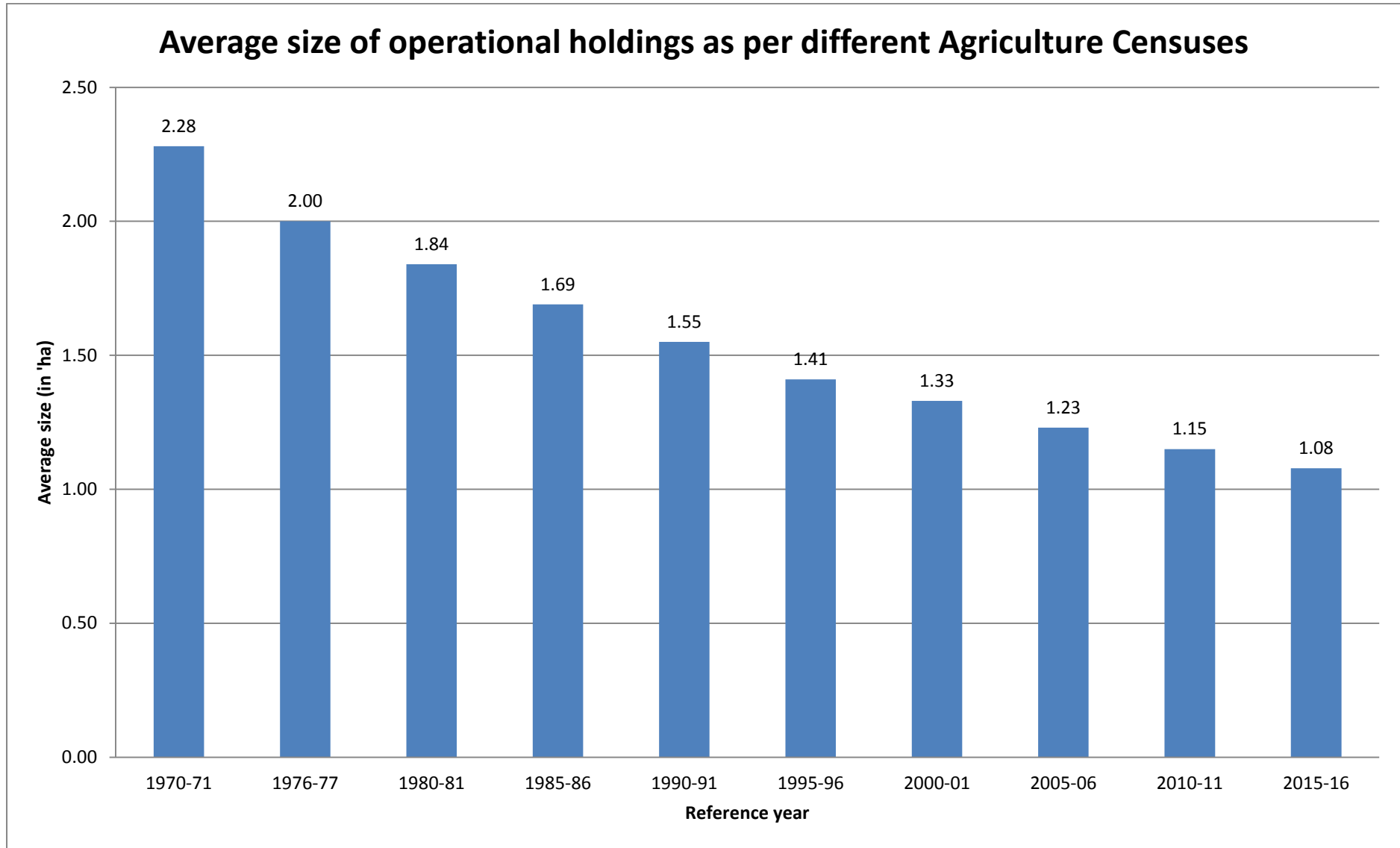
