According to Shisani, there are several irregularities in the land acquisition, which the PBS is keeping close to its chest right now. But Shisani says there are misrepresentations in the evaluation report by the forest department which wrongly claims there are no trees in the mangroves area. "We asked for the file of land acquisition proceedings under RTI in February 2010. They have still not given it to us. So we have appealed to the first appelate authority. They are play-ing games with us," Shisani said.

Residents have repeatedly petitioned authorities to cancel permissions to the roads.
